- 3. The areas of CSRG S.A., located at Chorzowska 25 Street, Chorzowska 12d Street, Krakowska 25 Street, Marklowicka 3 Street, are covered by video surveillance.
- 4. All data recorded by video surveillance cameras are stored and available for a minimum of 7 days. The storage time depends on the number of events and the disk capacity of the recorder. When the disk space runs out, the data is automatically overwritten. Only the image (no sound) is recorded and stored on the media.
- 5. Your personal data will not be disclosed to other entities, except as described in generally applicable laws. Only authorized employees of the Administrator and possibly an entity that processes your personal data on behalf of the Administrator on the basis of a contract of entrustment of personal data processing will have access to the data.
- 6. After obtaining information, on securing events recorded by video surveillance, the material is secured. It is made available upon written application submitted to CSRG S.A.. Secured data from video surveillance are made available only to authorities conducting proceedings on the recorded event, such as the Police, the Prosecutor's Office, the Courts.
- 7. Your personal data will be processed on the basis of Article 6 (1) f GDPR. i.e. based on the necessity of the processing for purposes arising from the legitimate interests pursued by the Administrator.
- 8. The legitimate interest pursued by the Company is the protection of property and ensuring security in the monitored area, which is also the purpose of personal data processing.
- 9. You have the right of access to the content of your data and the right to rectify, erase or restrict their processing, the right to data portability , the right to object.
- 10. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority if you consider that the processing of personal data concerning you violates the GDPR.
